Flower flies do not sting and are harmless to garden plants. In fact, they are beneficial at two life stages. As larvae (Photo 2), flower flies use a sucking mouthpart to feed on aphids and other small bodied pests that damage garden plants. A single larva can consume up to 400 aphids. As adults, flower flies visit flowers in search of nectar and pollen.

A microscopic nematode, *Steinernema feltiae*, enters crane fly or gnat larvae where it reproduces and releases lethal bacteria. Available at garden centers, these nematodes should be applied on cloudy days or at dusk because they are sensitive to light. Mix 1 teaspoon of the nematode powder in 1 gallon of water.

Whiteflies are small, flying insects that feed on the leaves of garden plants. Whiteflies may be as small as 1/12 inch long and may be very difficult to see with the naked eye. Look for the insects on the undersides of leaves during the day, when they are most active.

There are over 1,000 types of whiteflies, insects that look like small white moths or aphids. They group and breed in large numbers on the undersides of leaves. The nymphs and adults damage plants directly by sucking the sap and by transmitting disease. Once an infestation has taken root, it is difficult to remove.
