Fold both of your top corners to the opposite edge of the index card. Unfold. At the spot where the diagonal creases meet in the middle, fold your index card backward. Crease well, then unfold. When you're finished, your origami jumping frog should look like the picture to the left.

Fold the bottom of the paper up so that its edge meets the bottom of your triangle. Fold the two corners of the triangle up to form the "front legs" of the frog. Fold the sides inward to meet at the center. Fold the bottom of the paper upward so its edge touches the bottom of the "legs," and unfold right away.

Jumping Origami Frog Instructions - Wondermom Wannabe

Apply a small amount of glue on one portion of the smaller paper roll and stick it on the larger one. Now take the little piece of trimmed off paper (from the thinner strip) and glue on two wiggle eye stickers (or googly eyes or draw on your own). Cut above the eyes, making two arches.

Once your frog is folded, press down on the folded "legs" with the tip of your finger, then quickly slide your finger off to make the frog jump. Depending on how hard you push the legs down, you might be able to get the origami frog to make one perfect flip in the air and land on its feet again. It's fun to try to jump the frogs into targets, or just see whose frog jumps the furthest.

1. This is the front of our origami paper, the frog will end up being this colour. 2. This is the back of the paper, this colour will not be visible on our final frog. 3. Fold the right edge over to the left edge. 4. Fold the top right corner diagonally down to align with the left edge. 5.

STEP 1: Fold your origami jumping frog Once you have your supplies for the origami frog, pull out a piece of origami paper and fold it in half. Then, pull the top right hand corner over to form a triangle on the top half of the paper and crease it. Once you've done that, unfold it and repeat on each of the other corners.
